The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

Through CRM-M-5509-2021 – Baldev Singh @ Deba Vs. State of Punjab, the petitioner had earlier approached this Court for the grant of anticipatory bail which petition of his was dismissed on 05.02.2021 through the following order:-

“The arguments raised on behalf of the petitioner having not received a favourable response from the Bench and not to invite a decision on merits lest it may prejudice the case of the petitioner at a later stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.”

The petitioner has again knocked the doors of this Court seeking the same relief only on the ground that co-accused Jaswinder Singh @ Booli and Nisan Singh @ Nishan Singh @ Dhana have been granted ad interim anticipatory bail by this Court.

After perusal of the orders passed by this Court granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to co-accused Jaswinder Singh @ Booli and Nisan Singh @ Nishan Singh @ Dhana this Court of of the view that the ground of parity is not available to the petitioner as they had been granted such concession since they had been attributed simple injuries whereas the petitioner has been attributed a grievous injury.

Dismissed.
