Petitioners (Satinder Kaur and her husband Taranjit Singh) have filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution *inter alia* for setting aside the impugned summons dated 4.1.2021 (**Annexures P-1 and P-2**) issued by respondent no. 3 – Assistant Director, Directorate of Enforcement, Jalandhar, under Section 37(1) and (3) of the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999 (for short, 'the FEMA Act') read with Section 131 (1) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and Section 30 CPC, in connection with proceedings under the FEMA Act relating to one Rajesh Kapoor, with whom the petitioners claim to have no relations.

After arguing for some time and having failed to convince the Court, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.
