2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.240 dated 23.12.2019 registered under Section 22, NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 19.2.2020, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
