ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):

Vide this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. the petitioner prays for regular bail in FIR No.112 dated 29.05.2019, under Sections 326, 324, 323 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Upon hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner this court vide order dated 06.03.2020, had released the petitioner on interim bail:-

“The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail in case FIR No.112, dated 29.05.2019, registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

The Petitioner was arrested on 17.01.2020.

Admittedly, there is a delay of 16 days in

lodging the FIR and explanation for such delay is not entirely satisfactory.

Perusal of the MLR of the Victim along with Final Report reveals that Injury Nos.1 and 2 were undoubtedly simple in nature, Injury No.3 although described as grievous, actually happens to be a “superficial cut on lower 1/3 rd of Rt. Arm”.

Considering the long detention, so far, undergone by the present Petitioner, he is ordered to be released on an interim bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned, till the submission of challan.

Adjourned to 13.05.2020.”

Learned State counsel submits that the challan has since been presented on 08.01.2021. Further, the petitioner has not misused the concession of interim bail granted by this Court since 06.03.2020.

In the wake of the above, the order dated 06.03.2020, is made absolute.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
