The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 574 dated 05.08.2020, under Sections 147, 294 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sadar Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is a delay of three days in registering the FIR wherein it is alleged that the petitioner was roaming around the house of the complainant and had threatened him on phone.

This Court, by order dated 01.03.2021 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Virender Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 01.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
