Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No. 120 dated 04.12.2019, registered under Sections 308, 148, 149 of the IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Division No. 1, Jalandhar.

The operative part of the order dated 13.02.2020, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the matter stands compromised between the parties and a petition bearing CRM-M-6514-2020 has already been filed before this Court seeking quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise, in which notice of motion has been issued for 13.05.2020 and the parties have been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaqha Magistrate for recording of statement in support of the compromise.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Achin Gupta, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf the complainant and files his Vakalatnama. He admits to the factum of compromise entered into between the parties.

List again on 18.03.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 13.02.2020, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 13.02.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
