The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in his 5th attempt under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.9 dated 30.01.2017 under Sections 302, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Machhiwara, District Ludhiana, Punjab.

Petitioner is the main accused who has given repeated kirch blows on the head of the deceased.

FIR was registered at the instance of Mandeep Kaur with the allegations that her husband went outside the house on a call given by the petitioner. Thereafter, complainant heard

screams of her husband and she immediately came out of the house and saw that the petitioner along with two boys was giving beatings to her husband. Petitioner gave 2-3 kirch blow on the head of husband of the complainant and he fell down on the pile pebble stones. Thereafter, petitioner and others ran away from the spot.

Petitioner remained unsuccessful in four earlier attempts for seeking regular bail.

Learned State counsel submits that out of 20 PWs, 18 PWs have been examined after acceptance of application under Section 311 Cr.P.C. Out of remaining two PWs, examination-in-chief of one of the witness has been completed and his cross-examination is remaining. Second witness is to be examined completely. 11.05.2021 is the date fixed for further prosecution evidence.

Keeping in view the allegations and material on record, I do not see any ground to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
