Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had made two complainants against the officials of the Forest Department, Punjab, including respondents No.5 to 7 and on account of which the said officials bear a grudge against him and have been consistently threatening the petitioner with dire consequences. It has been submitted that although the petitioner had submitted the representation dated 30.12.2020 (Annexure P-1) to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 30.12.2020 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law at the earliest.

A copy of this order along with representation dated 30.12.2020 (Annexure P-1) be sent to respondent No.3 – the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana so as to enable him to comply with the aforesaid directions.
