Petitioner claims himself to be a resident of Khanna Town,
District Ludhiana, Punjab.

Instant petition has been filed seeking a mandamus for directing the respondent/authorities to implement a Scheme called AMRUT (Atal Mission Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation Scheme), the aim and objective of which is to provide basic services in the nature of water supply, sewerage and urban transport.

As per counsel, such Scheme was framed by the Central Government. Counsel urges that the concerned respondent/authorities have been lax and the Scheme is not being implemented which otherwise would have benefited the petitioner as also other residents of Khanna Town.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with a direction to respondents No.2 and 4 to examine the grievance of the petitioner against the backdrop of representations and reminders at

Annexures P-1 and P-2 and to thereafter take steps as may be deemed fit and warranted in accordance with law.
