The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.16, dated 15.03.2020 under Sections 420, 406, 120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Sadiq, District Faridkot.

In compliance of order dated 03.03.2021, learned State counsel has apprised the Court that the parties have entered into amicable settlement and the amount which the petitioner had allegedly taken from the complainant party stands returned.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has informed the Court that petition for quashing of the instant FIR has been filed before this Court in view of the compromise so arrived at between the parties. He submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 01.02.2021, hence he may be extended the concession of bail.

Mr. Harsimran, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has not refuted the factum of compromise having been arrived at between the parties.

Heard.

In the wake of the statements made by the learned counsel appearing for the complainant as well as learned State counsel, the petition as such is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to bail to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate. However, it is made clear that anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
