This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed for issuing directions to official respondents for conducting fair and impartial inquiry in FIR No. 531 dated 21.9.2020 under Section 20 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 61 of The Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (Haryana Amendment Bill, 2020) registered at Police Station Shahbad, District Kurukshetra.
