1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.11 dated 15.01.2021 registered under Sections 21(b) and 29 NDPS Act No.61 of 1985 at Police Station Guhla, District Kaithal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 26.02.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

3. Learned DAG, Haryana, on instructions from *ASI Tarsem Lal* confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 26.02.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, cooperated in the investigation, was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and his custodial interrogation is not required.

4. In view of the statement of the learned DAG, Haryana, order dated 26.02.2021, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
