Through this writ petition, the petitioner assails the correctness of order cancelling the previous order of transfer.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondent No.4 has managed to get the order of transfer cancelled within a few days of his transfer. He submits that respondent No.4 has filed Civil Writ Petition No.3667 of 2021 in which notice of motion was issued. However, during the pendency of the writ petition, respondent No.4 managed to get the order of transfer dated 12.02.2021 cancelled.

It may be noted here that Civil Writ Petition No.3667 of 2021 has already been disposed of.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondent No.4 has managed to stay in Rohtak for 9½ years out of his total service period of 12 years.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the petitioner to make a representation which shall be considered by the competent authority sympathetically within a period of

one month. It is expected that the competent authority will pass a speaking order on the representation so submitted.

Let the representation be submitted in this regard within a period of one week from today.
