The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.37 dated 10.02.2019 under Sections 498-A, 323 IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Phillaur District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner, who is married sister-in-law of the complainant, has been falsely implicated in the case in hand on account of matrimonial dispute between the complainant and her husband i.e. petitioner's brother. He further submits that pursuant to order dated 11.02.2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Daya Chand states that the petitioner is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 11.02.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
