The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.17 dated 10.01.2019 registered under Sections 5/13(2) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act 2015, 11-59-60 of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act and 120-B of IPC, Police Station Tauru, District Nuh, Haryana.

On 14.02.2020 following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is named Sarif son of Sadru, whereas Sharif son of Suleman was arrested along with Munfed at a 'naka' installed by the police. The petitioner had already sold the vehicle in question to the aforesaid Sharif son of Suleman and the vehicle was released on supeardari in favour of

Sharif son of Suleman only vide order dated 22.01.2019.

Notice of motion for 20.04.2020.

In the meanwhile , petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 19.02.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 14.02.2020, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jagdish admitted the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 14.02.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
