B.S. Walia, J. (VC)

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. After arguing for some, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press CRM-M-14211-2021 and the same may be permitted to be withdrawn, with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court, to file a petition for regular bail and directions being issued to the learned trial court to decide the same expeditiously.

3. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting upon the merits of the case, petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. (CRM-M-14211-2021), wherein challenge has been made to the order declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender, is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as prayed for. Resultantly, the petition seeking anticipatory bail under Section 482 Cr.P.C. (CRM-M-14041-2021) is also dismissed in the aforementioned terms. In the eventuality of the petitioner moving a petition for regular bail before the learned trial Court, the learned trial Court is directed to consider and decide the same, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
