Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.40 dated 07.03.2019 registered under Sections 307, 450, 325, 323, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27 and 30 of the Arms Act at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 14.02.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 14.02.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from SI Dineshwar Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 14.02.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
