Case taken up through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioners have since joined the investigation and on completion of the investigation, the challan has been filed in the Court, therefore, the concession of pre-arrest bail be allowed to the petitioners by way of acceptance of the present petition.

Learned counsel representing UT Chandigarh on instructions from SI Sant Ram has conceded the factum of petitioners having joined the investigation and on completion thereof, presentation of challan in the Court.

In that way, custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required. Accordingly, the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide

order dated 26.02.2020 is made absolute, subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. that the petitioners shall make themselves available for investigation by a police officer as and when required;
- 2. that they shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
- 3. that they shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.
- 4. that they shall surrender their passports before the Investigating Officer and if they are not having passports, then, shall file the affidavits in that regard.

In case, the petitioners violate any terms & conditions, on which the bail has been granted to them , the prosecution would be entitled to apply for cancellation of bail.

The petition stands allowed accordingly.
