The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.344 dated 15.12.2020, under Sections 336, 120-B IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, district Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that a video was posted on the facebook wherein co-accused were brandishing weapons but no weapon was fired. The petitioner was only present along with others and did not have any weapon in his hand. He also contends that the petitioner is 24 years of age and is not involved in any other case.

Issue notice to the respondent.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Senior DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the above especially when the petitioner is alleged to only be present along with other accused who have the weapons in their hands, no weapon was

in the hand of the petitioner, he is 24 years of age and is not involved in any other case, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, the petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and on his doing so, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer till submission of report under Section 173 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 ('Cr.P.C.' - for short). The petitioner shall continue to join investigation and shall furnish an undertaking that he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter, he will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
