This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

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For the reasons mentioned in the application, duly supported by an affidavit of the applicant, same is allowed as prayed for. Reply on behalf of respondent no.4 and documents Annexure R-4/1 to R-4/3 annexed along with the application, are taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

Application is disposed of.

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Prayer in this writ petition for a direction to respondent no.3 to decide petitioner's application in regard to transfer of ownership of Creta car bearing registration No. PB-62-B-3231, stated to have been purchased by petitioner from respondent no.4.

Short reply by way of affidavit dated 12.08.2021 of Karanbir Singh Chhina, Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Sangrur/respondent

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no.3 has been circulated on the Whatsapp group created for the purpose of video conferencing. Print out of the same be taken and attached with the file. It is stated therein that petitioner's application/representation stood decided on 15.04.2021, though a copy of the same was somehow not communicated due to oversight. It is observed in order dated 15.04.2021 that in view of the pending civil suit between petitioner and respondent no.4, necessary action cannot be taken as requested by the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Sunam on 09.03.2021.

In view of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition is rendered infructuous and same may be disposed of as such, however, liberty be afforded to the petitioner to challenge order dated 15.04.2021, if so advised.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous. Needless to say, petitioner is at liberty to challenge order dated 15.04.2021, in accordance with law, if so advised.
