Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.103 dated 11.03.2020, under Sections 420 and 188 IPC, registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that a message had been received by the petitioner on her mobile phone which contained the questions and answers for the secondary examination. He, however, contends that the petitioner did not forward the message to any other person. The co-accused Mandeep from whom message was received was granted regular bail on the same day on which he was arrested. The petitioner is a 31 year old lady with a minor child.

This Court, by the order dated 18.03.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satish Rathee, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 18.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
