The petitioners are retired employees of Department of Home, Punjab. They are all retired police officials. Through this writ petition, the petitioners claim that they were entitled to additional increments as per Assured Career Progression Scheme adopted by the Government vide notification dated 25.09.1998. The petitioners claim that certain colleagues have been granted relief vide judgment dated 06.12.2019 passed in CWP No.3946 of 2014 and other connected matters.

From the reading of the petition, it is apparent that the petitioners never filed any representation or lodged any claim in this regard before 16.12.2020. From the memo of parties, it is apparent that the petitioners retired between 8 to 18 years before filing of the writ petition.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Bench is not inclined to entertain the writ petition. Hence, the petitioners are relegated to the alternative remedy.
