The petitioner has filed a civil suit for grant of permanent prohibitory injunction restraining respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar from encroaching upon property acquired by the National Highway Authority of India. In the said suit, an application under Order 39 Rules 1 & 2 CPC has been filed but the trial Court is allegedly not deciding the same.

Considering the nature of order being passed in this case, issuance of notice of motion to the respondents is not necessary.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to Sh. Gursher Singh, Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Amritsar to decide the pending application for grant of temporary injunction in civil suit No.453 of 2021 titled as '*Jagjit Singh vs. State of Punjab and others*' expeditiously and in any case not later than two weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
