This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take appropriate action on the representation of the petitioner dated 20.11.2019 (Annexure P-1) against respondent Nos.4 to 6 for committing fraud against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the owner of two trallas (truck) bearing number PB-03-AJ-8011 and PB-03-Y-8703 and the private respondents by forging power of attorney have taken the possession of the same and thus, committed the offence of fraud with the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that though the SHO, Police Station, Canal Colony, District Bathinda, in his report dated 01.08.2020 has recommended registration of the FIR, however, till date no action has been taken in this regard. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already given a representation (Annexure P-1) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda for redressal of her grievances, however, no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, DAG, Punjab who is also appearing through video conferencing accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the submissions made by the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda as well as Station House Officer, concerned to dispose of the aforesaid representation after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as respondent Nos. 4 to 6 within a period of two months from today by following the guidelines laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Lalita Kumari vs. State of U.P. and others, 2013 (4) R.C.R. (Criminal) 979*.
