The petitioner had earlier approached this Court through CRM-M-32654-2020 – Kiranjeet Kaur vs. State of Punjab for the same relief as claimed in the present petition which petition of his was dismissed on 07.12.2020 through the following order:-

“The arguments raised on behalf of the petitioner having not received a favourable response from the Bench and not to invite a decision on merits lest it may prejudice the case of the petitioner at a later stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.”
