Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.45 dated 22.02.2018 under Section 302 Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 201, 317, 120-B IPC and Section 75 Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 added later on) registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the prosecution has examined 35 witnesses out of total 44 prosecution witnesses. It is evident that the trial is at the fag end and is likely to conclude in near future.

Considering the advanced stage of the trial, no case is made out for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.
