Petitioner – Vishal Sharma is the owner of a mortgaged residential house bearing House No. 763A, Block-A, Sushant Lok, Phase-I, Gurugram. The pleadings are not clear, however, it appears that the petitioner was one of the Directors of M/s Affinity Beauty Saloon Private Limited and the said property was offered as a collateral security for raising a loan of ₹ 4 crores by the private limited company from a Finance Company namely M/s Housing Development Finance Corporation Limited- Respondent no. 5.

The petitioner has rushed to this Court at this stage when the Naib Tehsildar-cum-Executive Magistrate, Wazirabad, District Gurugram was to visit on 1.3.2021 at 11.00 a.m. to take over physical possession in compliance of the order dated 10.12.2020 passed by the District Magistrate, Gurugram, under Section 14 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Securities Interest Act, 2002.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel realising that the pleadings in the writ petition are absolutely vague, prays for permission to withdraw the petition to enable his client to file a fresh one with better particulars.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
