The petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.228 dated 04.10.2020 registered under Sections 324, 323, 427, 452, 340, 148 and 149 Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 326 and 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the petitioner had previously filed the petition for grant of pre-arrest bail and the same was withdrawn vide order dated 15.01.2021.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer and states that the injuries suffered by Jawinder Singh inviting the offence punishable under Section 307 IPC has been attributed to the petitioner.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
