The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.116 dated 15.03.2019 under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar.

The petition was filed on behalf of Krishna Bhambri and Rama.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.2 was arrested and granted regular bail.

The petition is disposed of qua petitioner No.2 as infructuous.

While issuing notice of motion, the arrest of petitioner No.1 was stayed.

Learned State counsel has filed reply dated 26.10.2021 by way of an affidavit of Himadree Kaushik, ASP, Indri, Karnal. The relevant portion of para No.2 of the reply is quoted below:-

“That in compliance with the order dated 07.09.2021 the answering deponent after fair and impartial investigation found that the present petitioner Krishna has not committed any offence at the stage because there is no incriminative/material in the investigation against petitioner No.1 and found innocent. Moreover, as per investigation the petitioner No.1 on 24.07.2018 when the receipt of part payment was issued he has put his signature as witness. It is also pertinent to mention here that there is no signature on agreement and transfer deed.”

As per the reply filed, petitioner No.1 was found innocent as he had signed as witness on the receipt.

In view of the reply no further order is called for.

Petition is disposed of as infructuous.
