The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this writ petition, the petitioner after having failed to appear at the time fixed for scrutiny and verification of the documents for the purpose of recruitment to the post of Junior Assistant, prays for a direction to grant him another opportunity to appear before the Selection Committee.

The petitioner has pleaded that he missed his first chance due to a serious family problem.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner while referring to the orders passed on 08.06.2020 in Civil Writ Petition No.7704 of 2020 (Mukesh Rani and another vs. State of Haryana, decided on 08.06.2020) and Civil Writ Petition No.7685 of 2020 (Seema Devi vs. State of Haryana and another, decided on 15.06.2020) submits that, at this stage, he will be satisfied, if the respondents are directed to consider the claim of the petitioner.

Ms. Kirti Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has submitted that the Haryana Staff Selection Commission has no objection to consider and decide the request of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the Secretary of the Haryana Staff Selection Commission to decide the claim of the petitioner, within a period of one month from today, after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.
