Learned counsel for the petitioner herein prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.197 dated 20.07.2019 registered under Sections 307, 353, 186, 332, 506, 34 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

At this stage, learned counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions from ASI Harchetan Singh, would submit that in fact the petitioner has already been declared as proclaimed offender on 22.07.2020 and he is facing four other criminal cases. It is argued that in terms of the judgment in State of M.P Vs. Pradeep Sharma, 2014(1)R.C.R.(Criminal) 269, a person who has been declared a proclaimed offender, would not be entitled to the grant of anticipatory bail.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the instant petition and avail of the other remedies available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
