This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action on the complaint of the petitioner dated 21.01.2021 (Annexure P-2) against respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegation in the complaint, respondent No.3 has allegedly sold two tippers bearing number JH-06-L-0541 and JH-06-L-0549 on receiving a part payment and thereafter, the petitioner has paid some more amount to respondent No.3, however, the fact that the said tippers were financed by the Bank, was not disclosed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that while making a representation to the petitioner, the seller has concealed the aforesaid fact and has induced the petitioner to part away his money and has thus committed a cheating and fraud with him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that a representation/complaint dated 21.01.2021 (Annexure P-2) has already been given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala in this regard, however, no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, DAG, Punjab who is also appearing through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the submissions made by the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala as well as Station House Officer, concerned to dispose of the aforesaid representation/complaint after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as respondent No.3-Jagtar Singh within a period of two months from today, by following the guidelines laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Lalita Kumari vs. State of U.P. and others, 2013 (4) R.C.R. (Criminal) 979*.
