This is 2nd petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No.19 dated 08.02.2019 under Section 15/29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala; earlier one was dismissed as withdrawn on 16.02.2021.

After arguing the case for some time and finding that recovery is very heavy and the petitioner is involved in some other cases, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his arguments to the extent that this petition may be disposed of and a direction be issued to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously.

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Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate dated 09.03.2021 in the Court today and has submitted that out of total 13 prosecution witnesses, 03 PWs have already been examined and for recording statements of four more witnesses, next date before the trial Court is fixed on 26.03.2021.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of and the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of 06 months from today.
