This is a petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioner, seeking regular bail in case DDR No.54 dated 19.07.2020, under Sections 307/323/427/188/34 of the IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act (Section 34 of the IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act deleted and Sections 325/148/149 of the IPC, added later on) in FIR No.86, dated 18.07.2020, under Sections 307/323/34 of the IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

2. The petitioner has remained in custody for five months and twenty one days, since 29.09.2020, as per Custody Certificate dated 22.03.2021 sent up by Ld. State Counsel through e-mail.

3. After completion of investigation, Challan against the

petitioner has already been submitted. As such, he is not required for the purpose of investigation.

4. Ld. State Counsel has submitted that the offences under the provisions of the Arms Act, which were originally included in the DDR, have since been deleted by the Investigating Agency and Challan has been submitted against the petitioner for causing grievous injury to the victim punishable under Section 325 of the IPC, which is bailable.

5. Co-accused Lovepreet Singh has already been granted bail by this Court in CRM-M-39070-2020 on 02.12.2020.

6. In such circumstances and without making any further comments on the merits of the case, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period is not called for. Therefore, his prayer for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail, subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
