Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No. 399 dated 18.08.2020, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 IPC and Sections 325 and 307 IPC were added later on, at Police Station Sadar Sonipat, District Sonipat.

On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner had raised a plea that there was a delay of 11 days in lodging the FIR. Today, while contradicting the said stand, learned State counsel points out that there was no delay in lodging the FIR and rather a head injury on the person of the

complainant, is attributed to the petitioner.

At this, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition, at this stage.

Allowed as prayed for. Dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of one week from today.
