The petitioner pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.84 dated 13.08.2019, registered under Section 212 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 & Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station City Zira, District Ferozepur.

The operative part of the order dated 03.03.2021, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner had given shelter to co-accused, namely, Gurpreet Singh. He also contends that the petitioner is 22 years of age and there is no allegation against him for the commission of any offence punishable under the Arms Act.

Issue notice to the respondent. ”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 03.03.2021, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Anwar Masih,

has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation. He further submits that challan has been presented.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 03.03.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
