MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By means of this writ petition filed under Articles 226 Constitution of India, petitioner has prayed for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect her life and liberty from private respondent Nos.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that petitioner is major and she is facing threats from the private respondents, who are respective parents and grand parents of petitioner, as they are bent upon to marry her by force and against her wishes. It is further submitted that father of petitioner used to give beatings to her and her siblings, therefore, on 15.12.2020, petitioner ran away from her house and is now living with one lady, namely, Ms. Manjeet Dhillon at Amritsar. As per the pleadings, respondent Nos.4 and 5 threatened the petitioner telephonically that they will implicate her in a false case. In this regard, a representation dated 27.12.2020 (Annexure P-3) has been submitted to Station House Officer, Amritsar by the petitioner, but no action has been taken so far. He prays for

issuance of necessary directions.

After hearing the learned counsel, this Court finds that the petitioner has not produced any medical record or complaint to substantiate the allegations of beatings by respondent No.4 (father of petitioner). Apart from this, the relevant details and particulars of the alleged phone calls made by the parents of the petitioner are neither contained in the writ petition nor in the representation. As per the pleadings, petitioner has only expressed apprehension that a false case would be lodged against her, therefore, this Court does not find it to be a fit case for exercise of extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
