Status report by way of affidavit of Yogesh Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-1, Patiala, District Patiala has been filed by learned State counsel alongwith the statement of petitioner No. 1 (Annexure R-1), who stated that they do not apprehend any danger from respondent No. 4.
