This petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.146 dated 10.10.2020, under Sections 307, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station, Daresi, District Ludhiana. The petitioners apprehend their arrest at the hands of police in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that the petitioners were not named in the FIR initially and even otherwise, as per the allegations, 8-10 persons had attacked the victim, who only suffered one injury.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Ram, has pointed out that the petitioners were indicted as accused on the basis of the supplementary statement given by the complainant. According to him, the sole injury suffered by the victim is attributed to Hardeep, who is in custody.

Considering the above background, the petition is allowed and it is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to anticipatory bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall join the investigation as and when called by the police.
