1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.04 dated 09.02.2021, registered under Sections 353, 186, 342, 323, 332 and 506 IPC at Police Station Jodhan, District Ludhiana.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 15.03.2021, the petitioners joined investigation, fully cooperated in the same, were released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that their custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned AAG, Punjab, on instructions from *ASI Gurmeet Singh*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 15.03.2021, the petitioners joined investigation, fully cooperated in the same, were released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that in the circumstances, their custodial interrogation is not required.
