Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.09 dated 17.01.2021, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged by the complainant, who is the mother-in-law of the petitioner and mother of the deceased, that the petitioner, who is the wife of the deceased, was in a relationship with another person due to which the deceased committed suicide. He also contends that there is no suicide note or any material to indicate that the petitioner was harassing the deceased with an intention to compel him to commit suicide.

This Court, by the order dated 03.03.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 03.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
