ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.17 dated 04.02.2021, under Sections 324, 452, 506, 427 and 34 IPC and Section 326 added later on vide Rapat No.22 dated 14.02.2021, registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is motivated and the petitioner has been falsely implicated. It is alleged that 03 persons had attacked the complainant but only one injury was found on his person.

Issue notice to the respondent.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. He upon instructions from Sub-Inspector Rajwinder Singh states that the petitioner is duly named in the FIR and he has been attributed a gandasi blow on the left hand of the injured. The MLR indicates 03 fractures on the fingers of the left hand of the complainant.

Heard.

It is alleged by the complainant that the petitioner had tried to give a gandasi blow on the head of the complainant, when he raised his hand to save himself, the blow struck his hand. The MLR of the injured reflects incised wound over dorsal aspect of left hand with the injury extending from index finger to little finger. After the x-ray examination, fracture of proximal phalanx of index, middle and ring finger was observed.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner having caused serious injuries resulting in 03 fractures on the fingers of the left hand of the complainant, I do not deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed.
