The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 553 dated 21.09.2019, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 379-B, 506 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station City Ballabhgarh, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR was registered at the instance of complainant Surender against Akshat, Deepak, Aryan, Manish Kapasia, Vikrant @ Bakra, petitioner Sanjeev Kapasia and others for threatening him and causing injuries. It is stated in the FIR that when the complainant's youngest son Dipanshu, along with his friend Ankit, was going to his house, all the accused persons including petitioner, carrying sticks etc., stopped them and started beating. On hearing the noise, some neighbours came there and saved them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is not specifically attributed any injury, however, learned State counsel has raised an objection that petitioner is evading arrest since 21.09.2019 and he is involved in four other FIRs of the similar nature.

Learned State counsel also submits that real brother of the petitioner, namely Manish Kapasia, is also an accused in the present case and all the accused have caused multiple injuries, which include multiple fractures on the body of the victim and they have also snatched Rs.8,000/- from the victim.

After hearing learned counsel for the partes, considering the fact that multiple injuries were caused to victim by the petitioner and other accused and also in view of the fact that petitioner is evading his arrest for the last about 01 year and 09 months, I do not find any ground to grant him concession of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
