ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)

This is a petition filed under Section 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to look into the grievance of the petitioner and decide the representation (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate action against respondent Nos.4 to 10 in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a senior citizen and previously, paternal aunt of petitioner, namely Gurnam Kaur daughter of Veer Singh, has adopted the petitioner. Gurnam Kaur died on 08.10.1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that Gurnam Kaur was the owner of 08 acres of agriculture land and she had executed a registered Will on 15.10.1982 in favour of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in the year 2010, one Kishan Chand Bhatia, who has a land adjoining with the land of the petitioner, tried to take possession of the same and on account of which, dispute arose between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that now the petitioner had obtained a copy of revenue record i.e. Jamabandi (Fard), in which Kishan Chand Bhatia is shown to be the owner of half acre of land.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that on verification, it was further found that one Jagtar Singh has prepared a forged Will of aforesaid Gurnam Kaur and on the basis of the same, the land got inherited in his name in the year 2012 and thereafter, it appears that he has transferred the land in favour of Kishan Chand Bhatia.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that private respondents are trying to take the possession of the said land.

Be whatsoever, on the fact of it, it is a civil dispute and no direction can be issued to the police authorities to verify about the possession or validity of the aforesaid Will.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
