The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference  
due to COVID-19 situation.

This petition in the nature of Habeaus Corpus was filed for the  
release of detainee namely Charanjit Kaur from the illegal custody of  
private respondents.

Today, learned State counsel has filed the status report by way  
of an affidavit of Shailendra Singh, PPS, Superintendent of Police, PBI &  
Operations, Amritsar (Rural)-cum-Head SIT. The same is taken on record.

It is pleaded that Darshan Singh (father of the detainee) was  
taken in remand and in his disclosure statement before the SIT he disclosed  
that his daughter Charanjit Kaur (detainee) was murdered. Thereafter,

under Sections 342, 344, 345, 364, vide DDR/Rapat No. 44 dated 15.03.2021 on instructions of the SIT.

Learned State counsel submits that the matter is being investigated and all sincere efforts would be made to complete the investigation expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of status report filed, no cause of actions survives for pursuing the present petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for the redressal of the grievance, if any.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
