The petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect their life and liberty, as they apprehend danger from respondents No.5 to 14, who are against the marriage of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel has produced the copies of the statements of petitioners dated 03.04.2021, wherein, they have expressed that they do not apprehend any danger. Statements of respondents have also been recorded, wherein, they have stated that they have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute this fact and submits that in view of the statements of petitioners, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
