TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA J.(Oral)

Mr. Abhay Pal Singh Gill, Asst.A.G. Punjab, informs the Court that the petitioner would have an efficacious alternate remedy of filing a representation/petition before the District Committee under The Punjab Regulation of Fee of Unaided Educational Institution Act 2016. He further submits that in the eventuality of the petitioner preferring a petition/representation, the District Committee would take up the matter and take a decision on merits expeditiously and in any case within a period of two weeks from the date of filing of such representation.

Counsel for the petitioner is not opposed to such course of action.

In view of the above, writ petition is disposed of.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a representation/petition before the District Committee under The Punjab Regulation of Fee of Unaided Educational Institution Act 2016.

Directions are issued for the District Committee to take a

decision on merits in the matter within a period of 10 days from the date of submission of representation/petition.

It is clarified that this Court has not examined the case on merits.
