The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 232 dated 24.12.2018, under Sections 457 and 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No. 7, Jalandhar.

This Court vide order dated 26.2.2020, granted the interim bail subject to joining investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI-Kanwaljit Singh submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are co-operating.

Though the complainant has not been impleaded as party, Mr. Navkiran Singh, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of the complainant and opposes the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail.

As no custodial interrogation of the petitioners is needed, the interim bail granted on 26.2.2020 is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
