Case taken up through Video Conferencing.

Through CRM-M-1787-2021- Lakhan and another vs. State of Haryana the petitioner along with his co-accused had earlier approached this Court for the same relief as claimed in the present petition which petition of his was dismissed by this Court on 14.01.2021 through the following order:-

"The arguments raised on behalf of the petitioners having not received a favourable response from the Bench and not to invite a decision on merits lest it may prejudice the case of the petitioners at a later stage, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present petition.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn."

A perusal of the afore quoted order reveals that the earlier petition filed by the petitioner for the same relief had been withdrawn after the arguments raised on his behalf did not receive a favourable response from the Bench.

Admittedly, there is no change of circumstance after the dismissal of the petitioner's first petition. That being so, this Court is not inclined to grant to the petitioner the relief claimed through the instant petition.
