ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is doing a private job and is residing in a rented accommodation, in the house of one Dalbara Singh, where she is residing with her mother and minor brother. It is further submitted that respondent No.4 wants to grab property of the petitioner (detail of the property is not given in the entire petition or the representation).

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Learned State counsel has, however, submitted that as per allegations in the complaint, respondent No.4 has extended threat to the petitioner and aforesaid Dalbara Singh, landlord of the petitioner, but said Dalbara Singh has never approached the police authorities that respondent No.4 has ever visited his house.

Even otherwise, a bare perusal of the complaint shows that the petitioner has grievance against respondent No.4 Balbir Singh that he wants to take her property, for which the petitioner has alternative and efficacious remedy of filing a civil suit for injunction against respondent No.4.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and finding no ground to entertain the present petition, same is dismissed.
